AN ORDINANCE

ADOPTING AND ESTABLISHING THE MASTER SALARY FOR THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN, CONTAINED IN EXHIBIT "A" HERETO ATTACHED AND MADE A PART HEREOF, WHICH INCORPORATES ALL AMENDMENTS TO DATE. CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ESTABLISHES AND ADOPTS THE ATTACHED MASTER SALARY ORDINANCE DATED JANUARY 1, 2012, AND INCORPORATES ALL AMENDMENTS TO DATE, AS THE MASTER SALARY ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN REFLECTING ALL EXISTING EMPLOYEE POSITIONS WHETHER CURRENTLY FILLED OR VACANT AND THEIR SALARIES, AND AS MAY BE AMENDED BY COUNCIL PURSUANT TO ORDINANCES THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2012, HEREBY REPEALING ALL PRIOR MASTER SALARY ORDINANCES ADOPTED BY COUNCIL, EXCEPT FOR USE AS HISTORICAL REFERENCE; AND

PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX OF THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.

That the salary ordinance attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and dated January 1, 2012, and incorporating all amendments to date, is hereby adopted and established as the Master Salary Ordinance for the City of Youngstown, reflecting all existing employee positions whether currently filled or vacant and their salaries, and as may be amended by Council pursuant to ordinances through December 31, 2012, hereby repealing all prior master salary ordinances adopted by Council, except for use as historical reference.

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AN ORDINANCE

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AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF CONTROL OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN TO **ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH MARTA ANNE POLUSE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR COMMENCING ON OR ABOUT JANUARY, 2012 AND ENDING JANUARY 1, 2013. THE COST OF SERVICES SHALL NOT EXCEED \$27,248.00; AND**

FURTHER, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF CONTROL TO APPROVE ANY CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT(S) REQUIRED TO EXECUTE SAID PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT. FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE AND WILL BE EXPENDED FROM THE 2012 POLICE UNIFORM PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CODE 2101.12.202.5817; AND

THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT ANTICIPATES FINAL APPROVAL OF A GRANT AWARD FROM THE OHIO OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES FOR THE "PROJECT FORECAST" CRIME FIGHTING INITIATIVE IN THE NEAR FUTURE. THE GRANT AWARD NUMBER IS 2011-JG-A02-6910. THE FUNDS AWARDED TO THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN BY THIS OCJS PROJECT FORECAST GRANT, WOULD BE SUFFICIENT TO FUND THE TOTAL COST OF THE PROPOSED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT; AND

PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX OF THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.
